1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History 8 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 10 June 30, 2001.....\$ 8,528,335.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 14 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the 15 purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 16 year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 17 2,158,982.00. 18 SECTION 3. 44 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 45 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 46 47 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 48 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 49 50 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 52 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 53 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 55 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 56 57 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 58 59 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"

60 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 61 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 62 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

70 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 71 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 72 73 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 74 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 75 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 76 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 77 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 98 SECTION 8. 99 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 100 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 101 Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the 102 expenditure of State General Funds, as authorized in House Bill No. 1628, Regular Session of 1999, for the electronic cataloging 103 104 system and public access catalog, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 97,500.00. 105

106 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing 107 the expenditure of State General Funds for the acquisition, 108 installation and implementation of an electronic cataloging system 109 and public access catalog, and for related staff training needs.

110 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 111 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 112 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.

SECTION 9. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

118 SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 119 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 120 121 Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of the State General Funds, as authorized in House 122 123 Bill 1628, Regular Session of 1999, for restoring the Beulah Cemetery, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 124 125 

This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of State General Funds to restore the historic Beulah Cemetery, a National Register of Historic Places property in Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balances of June 30, 2000.

147 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 148 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 149 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.

SECTION <u>12</u>. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 150 151 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 152 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 153 154 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 155 156 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000. 157
