Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Eighty-five Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$85,216.00) is provided to fund salary and office expense for one (1) full-time legal assistant in the Sixth Circuit Court District as authorized in Section 25-31-5(2)(f), Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 4.
