Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 43 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 2,
Twenty-four Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-six Dollars
(\$24,896.00) is provided for the Mississippi Fire Personnel
Minimum Standards and Certification Board.

78 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 79 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 81 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 83 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 85 and after July 1, 2000.
