HOUSE BILL NO. 1621

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 2 3 MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND THE MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR 4 THE DEAF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board of 8 Education for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 9 10 Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for the Deaf for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 11 12 June 30, 2001.....\$ 10,026,706.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 14 15 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Education for the support of the Mississippi School for the Blind 16 17 or the Mississippi School for the Deaf which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the 18 schools, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the schools 19 20 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 21 June 30, 2001.....\$ 927,576.00. SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 2.2 Section 1 and Section 2, the following positions are authorized: 23 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 24 25 Permanent: Full Time..... 207 26 Part Time.... 32 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 27 2

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Part Time....

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 29 30 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 31 32 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 33 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 34 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 35 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 36 37 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 38 39 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 40 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 41 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 42 43 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 44 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 45 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 46 47 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 48 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 49 50 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

51 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by general law. 52 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 53 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 54 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 55 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein provided shall be expended to hire any person on a contractual basis, for any period for any purpose, without the express prior approval of the State Personnel Director. The State Personnel Director shall consider, in approving such contracts, the availability of funds, the need for

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services, compliance with the State Compensation Plan and the
qualifications of the persons offering to perform the services.
The State Fiscal Officer shall not pay any warrant that is in
violation of this section.

65 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for 66 67 the Deaf shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this 68 69 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 70 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2000. The Department of Finance and Administration shall insure that financial controls 71 72 comparable to those utilized for Fiscal Year 2000 are maintained 73 throughout Fiscal Year 2001 for this agency. The State Personnel 74 Board shall insure that personnel controls and records comparable to those utilized for Fiscal Year 2000 are maintained throughout 75 76 Fiscal Year 2001 for this agency. It is further the intention of 77 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2002 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 78 79 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 80 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request 81 process.

SECTION 5. With the funds provided herein, it is the intention of the Legislature that the academic teachers at the Mississippi School for the Deaf and the Mississippi School for the Blind shall receive their annual increment.

86 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 87 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 88 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 89 90 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 91 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 92 and after July 1, 2000. 93

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
