AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 2 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL 3 YEAR 2001. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying 8 9 out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 10 June 30, 2001.....\$ 10,931,593.00. 11 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 14 Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds 15 collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the 16 purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal 17 year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 18 2,709,613.00. 19 20 SECTION 3. 44	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
45	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
46	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
47	Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
48	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
49	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
50	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
51	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
52	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
53	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
54	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
55	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
56	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
57	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
58	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
59	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

60 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 63 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

With the funds provided herein, it is the 110 intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library 111 Commission shall provide Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to the family resource grants. 112 113 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to 114 115 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 116 Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 117 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 118 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 119 120 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 121 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 122 123 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 124 125 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from

126 and after July 1, 2000.
