HOUSE BILL NO. 1627
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE
2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE
3 STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
4 2001.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters
9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board
10 of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning
11 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 24,300.00.

12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15 expenditure:

32 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
33 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

34 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
35 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
36 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
37 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

38 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
39 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
40 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
41 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
42 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
43 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

44 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
45 and after July 1, 2000.
