170 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 171 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 172 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 173 174 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 175 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 176 177 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 178 179 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 180 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 181 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 182 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 183 184 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 185 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 186 187 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 188 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 189 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 190 191 It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive

192 Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 193 194 positions not to exceed five percent (5%) of the receiving office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 195 196 accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 197 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 198 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of 199 200 Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month 201 prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 202 203 provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 204 alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 205 206 in the original appropriations made under this act.

207 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 208 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 209 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 210 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 211 212 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 213 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 214 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi 215 Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 216 217 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 218\$ 4,000,000.00. 219 SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 220 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 221 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 222 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for 223 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 224 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 225 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 226 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. 227 228 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 229 230 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 231 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 232 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 233 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 234 235 and after July 1, 2000.
