AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' 2 3 4 RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE 5 RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of 9 10 the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of 11 the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in 12 13 the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building 14 Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System 15 Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 16 June 30, 2001.....\$ 7,240,201.00. 17 SECTION 2. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 40 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 45 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 49 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 51 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 52 53 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 57 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 58 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 60 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

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SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
allocated in Section 2 in the category "Personal Services:
Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," not more than Fifty Thousand
Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be used to pay overtime compensation
for work on data processing records after regular office hours.

70 SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary while remaining within the project cost of Thirteen 71 72 Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$13,260,000.00), is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the 73 74 credit of the Administrative Expense Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of defraying the 75 76 expenses of implementing the information technology plan known as 77 "Genesis," for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 78 June 30, 2001.....\$750,000.00.

79 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 80 81 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 82 83 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 84 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 85 86 and after July 1, 2000.

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
