31 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 33 34 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 37 38 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 40 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 41 act. 42 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized.
