With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 36 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 37 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 42 43 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 44 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 45 46 Services" when annualized.
