AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND FOR RELATED 3 4 PURPOSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation Funds, for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the 9 10 Mississippi Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 11 12 .....\$ 936,508,743.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following offices are supported by the funds appropriated in Section 1: The Office of Administrative Services, 14 15 the Office of Highways, the Office of Aeronautics and Rails and the Office of Enforcement. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 41 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 43 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 45 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 act. 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 48 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 49 50 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 51 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 52 53 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 54 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 55 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 56 57 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

58 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

59 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 60 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

61 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 62 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

63 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi 64 Department of Transportation under the provisions of Section 1 and 65 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, the following amounts 66 shall be available for expenditure in the program budgets as 67 required by Section 27-103-127, Mississippi Code of 1972:

Administration and Other Expenses.....\$ 36,800,000.00 68 69 Construction.....\$ 692,789,129.00 70 Maintenance.....\$ 149,473,445.00 71 Debt Service.....\$ 45,146,169.00 Law Enforcement.....\$ 72 8,700,000.00 73 Aeronautics, Rails and other.....\$ 3,600,000.00 74 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of 75 76 the Legislature that One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) 77 shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce 78 for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal 79 Year 2001.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 80 81 this act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation may expend out of these funds such sums as may be necessary to provide 82 83 transportation and transportation related services, including the operation or use of buses, vans or other vehicles owned or leased 84 by the Mississippi Department of Transportation, in support of the 85 86 annual meeting of the Southern Legislative Conference hosted by 87 the State of Mississippi.

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi Department of Transportation, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall be used for the Statewide Litter Prevention Program.

92 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 93 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority

94 to escalate and expend funds from any proceeds arising from 95 participation in drug seizure activities not to exceed Fifty 96 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

SECTION 8. Of the construction funds appropriated in Section 97 98 1 and allocated in Section 2, it is the intention of the Legislature that priority shall be given in letting paving 99 100 contracts on grade, drain and bridge projects which have been completed for six (6) months or more. This action will not 101 102 prohibit the Department of Transportation from letting paving 103 contracts on grade, drain and bridge projects which have been 104 completed for less than six (6) months.

SECTION 9. Of the funds herein appropriated, up to Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) may be used to move buildings from property authorized for conveyance in House Bill No. 523, Regular Session 2000.

109 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 110 Executive Director of the Department of Transportation may 111 transfer between the various programs authorized in Section 3 112 funds not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total funds 113 authorized in Section 1, except that transfers cannot be made into 114 the "Administration and Other Expense Program." The Executive Director of the Department of Transportation shall submit written 115 116 justification for the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office 117 and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month prior to the effective date of the 118 119 transfer.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Transportation be allowed to escalate its budget in the "Capital Outlay" major object of expenditure and the appropriate corresponding program, with funds generated as a result of third party damages an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).

SECTION 12. The Mississippi Department of Transportation is

127 hereby authorized and directed to conduct a pilot maintenance 128 project on U. S. Highway 78 between the Tennessee and Alabama 129 state lines that is projected to save the department monies over a 130 five-year period.

131 SECTION 13. Of the funds herein appropriated, funds in the 132 amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) are provided 133 to construct turn lanes to Highway 145 to improve safety and 134 accessibility to Saltillo High School at Saltillo.

SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Transportation be allowed to escalate its budget in either the "Capital Outlay" or "Commodities" major object of expenditure and the Maintenance Program, with funds which were obligated in Fiscal Year 2000 for maintenance overlay projects and maintenance repair projects but not completed before the end of the Fiscal Year 2000.

SECTION 15. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money not expended in Fiscal Year 2000 by the Department of Transportation in the equipment category for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001......\$ 1,100,000.00.

147 SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 148 149 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 150 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 151 152 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from 153 154 and after July 1, 2000.
