5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPP		
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
8	Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation Funds,		
9	for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the		
10	Mississippi Department of Transportation for the fiscal year		
11	beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001		
12	\$ 948,008,743.00.		
13	SECTION 2. The following offices are supported by the funds		
14	appropriated in Section 1: The Office of Administrative Services,		
15	the Office of Highways, the Office of Aeronautics and Rails and		
16	the Office of Enforcement. Of the funds appropriated under the		
17	provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below		
18	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

- 74 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 75 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of
- 76 the Legislature that One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)
- 77 shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce
- 78 for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal
- 79 Year 2001.
- SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 81 this act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation may expend
- 82 out of these funds such sums as may be necessary to provide
- 83 transportation and transportation related services, including the
- 84 operation or use of buses, vans or other vehicles owned or leased
- 85 by the Mississippi Department of Transportation, in support of the
- 86 annual meeting of the Southern Legislative Conference hosted by
- 87 the State of Mississippi.
- 88 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi
- 89 Department of Transportation, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 90 (\$300,000.00) shall be used for the Statewide Litter Prevention
- 91 Program.
- 92 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 93 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority

- 94 to escalate and expend funds from any proceeds arising from
- 95 participation in drug seizure activities not to exceed Fifty
- 96 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).
- 97 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 98 Executive Director of the Department of Transportation may
- 99 transfer between the various programs authorized in Section 3
- 100 funds not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total funds
- 101 authorized in Section 1, except that transfers cannot be made into
- 102 the "Administration and Other Expense Program." The Executive
- 103 Director of the Department of Transportation shall submit written
- 104 justification for the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office
- 105 and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the
- 106 fifteenth of the month prior to the effective date of the
- 107 transfer.
- 108 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 109 Department of Transportation be allowed to escalate its budget in
- 110 the "Capital Outlay" major object of expenditure and the
- 111 appropriate corresponding program, with funds generated as a
- 112 result of third party damages an amount not to exceed Two Million
- 113 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).
- 114 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 115 Department of Transportation be allowed to escalate its budget in
- 116 either the "Capital Outlay" or "Commodities" major object of
- 117 expenditure and the Maintenance Program, with funds which were
- 118 obligated in Fiscal Year 2000 for maintenance overlay projects and
- 119 maintenance repair projects but not completed before the end of
- 120 the Fiscal Year 2000.
- 121 SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 122 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money not expended
- 123 in Fiscal Year 2000 by the Department of Transportation in the
- 124 equipment category for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and
- 125 ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 1,100,000.00.
- 126 SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, One

Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall come 127 from the Mississippi Public Service Special Fund 3811 and Ten 128 129 Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall come from the Mississippi Public Service Commission Special Fund 3812, it is the intention 130 131 of the Legislature that the Department of Transportation shall transfer from any special funds available to the State Department 132 of Transportation except the funds provided by the Mississippi 133 134 Public Service Commission Eleven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11,500,000.00) to the State General Fund. 135 136 SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 137 138 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 139 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 140 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 141

SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2000.
