HOUSE BILL NO. 1721 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF OLIVE BRANCH TO OPERATE ITS 2 NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS OUTSIDE THE 3 CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OLIVE BRANCH; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing 7 authorities of the City of Olive Branch in DeSoto County, 8 Mississippi, in their discretion, may construct, expand, operate 9 10 and maintain a natural gas distribution system to provide natural gas service to the following described tract, if the area within 11 the tract is not certificated to another natural gas utility for 12 13 such service, or if certificated, upon obtaining a release from that utility, or cancellation pursuant to Section 77-3-21, 14 15 Mississippi Code of 1972, and obtaining a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Public Service Commission. 16 17 Beginning at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of Section 5; Township 3 South; Range 6 West; 18 thence east 2.6 miles along the half section lines of 19 20 Sections 5, 4, and 3 to a point in the centerline of the Coldwater River; then southwestward along the meanders 21 of the Coldwater River to the southwest corner of 2.2 Section 19; thence north 3.0 miles along the west line 23 of Sections 19, 18 and 7 to the northwest corner of 24 25 Section 7 and a point in Camp Creek Canal; thence north 26 2,640 feet along the centerline of said Canal to a point on the half section line of Section 6; thence east 5,000 27

feet along the half section line to the point of

beginning, and containing 5,020 acres, more or less.

30 Whenever such natural gas utility service is furnished to any 31 consumer residing outside the corporate limits of the City of 32 Olive Branch, the consumer may not be charged at a rate greater 33 than twice the rate charged for the same service within the 34 corporate limits of the City of Olive Branch.

(2) The authority conferred by this act shall not be 35 construed as an exemption from the provisions of Chapter 3, Title 36 77, Mississippi Code of 1972. The City of Olive Branch shall be 37 required to obtain from the Public Service Commission a 38 certificate of public convenience and necessity, obtain approval 39 40 of all rates and charges for providing natural gas service to those areas that are more than one (1) mile outside its corporate 41 boundaries, and otherwise shall be subject to the jurisdiction of 42 43 the Public Service Commission as authorized by applicable law.

44 (3) The governing authorities of the City of Olive Branch 45 shall provide natural gas service to each consumer within the 46 distribution system who requests such service. For the purpose of 47 this subsection, the term "distribution system" means all areas 48 that are described in subsection (1) of this section.

(4) The governing authorities of the City of Olive Branch shall file annually with the State Auditor for his review a financial report on the natural gas distribution system. The audited financial statements shall be maintained in the office of the system for public inspection and shall be made available to the public during normal business hours.

55 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 56 and after its passage.
