6 WHEREAS, a native of St. Thomas in the Virgin Islands, Ms. 7 Reece did not begin playing volleyball until her junior year of 8 high school when she moved to St. Petersburg, Florida; and

9 WHEREAS, after graduating from high school, Ms. Reece earned 10 an athletic scholarship to Florida State University, where she 11 majored in communications; and

12 WHEREAS, while playing for Florida State University, Ms.
13 Reece set two school volleyball records which still stand with 240
14 solo blocks and 747 total blocks, was named the nation's Most
15 Inspiring Collegiate Athlete by the Dodge National Athletic Awards
16 Committee in 1990 and earned All-Tournament honors several times
17 throughout her collegiate career; and

18 WHEREAS, in 1989, Ms. Reece began her modeling career while 19 managing her academics in summer school and returning for the 20 volleyball season; and

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Reece has been seen on the cover of magazines

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Reece played in the 1998 Cuervo Beach City 25 Challenge Series with top men and women players and is competing 26 domestically in the 1999-2000 Olympic Challenge Series, the 27 1999-2000 FIVB Beach Volleyball Tour and several other domestic 28 campaigns; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Reece has led the Women's Beach Volleyball League in several different categories including kills from 1993 to 1996, blocks in 1993, kills per match set in 1994 and 1996, kills in season set in 1996, kills in a tournament and total attempts in a tournament in 1994; and
