- WHEREAS, Dr. Husley, author of numerous articles on American
- 21 Civil War, American South, and maritime history, has designed,
- 22 constructed and illustrated a wide range of museum exhibits
- 23 nationally; and

- 25 organizations, including the American Association of Museums, the
- 26 American Association for State and Local History, the Mississippi
