- WHEREAS, Mr. Esteam Hill departed this life on February 27,
- 5 2000, causing great loss to his family and friends; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill, son of Spencer and Suguella Hill, was born
- 7 the sixth of thirteen children on August 12, 1914, in Silver
- 8 Creek, Mississippi; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill attended the Silver Creek School System and
- 10 joined the United States Army in 1944, where he served his country
- 11 until January 10, 1946; and
- 12 WHEREAS, an active member of his community, Mr. Hill, a
- 13 former baseball player for the Negro Baseball League, was a member
- 14 of Ebenezer Baptist Church for 56 years, where he served as
- 15 president of the Senior Choir, a member of the finance committee,
- 16 a Deacon and a member of the Board of Trustees; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was married to the former Callie Chester,
- 18 and from that union five children were born; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in addition to his full-time job at Hercules, Mr.
- 20 Hill worked part time as a painter, landscaper, carpenter and
- 21 taxicab driver; and
- 22 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 23 outstanding Mississippians such as Mr. Esteam Hill, a devoted
- 24 husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather:
