HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 110  
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 MADISON CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL "JAGUARS" FOOTBALL TEAM FOR WINNING  
3 THE STATE 5A CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, the Madison Central High School "Jaguars" Football  
5 Team completed the 1999 season with a perfect 15-0 record and won  
6 the State 5A Championship on statewide television; and

7 WHEREAS, the Jaguars were ranked No. 1 in the Jackson  
8 Clarion-Ledger Super 10 Poll and were ranked 13th in the nation by  
9 the USA Today High School Football Poll; and

10 WHEREAS, in addition to the State Championship, this football  
11 team won the District 6, Division 4, Class 5A Championship  
12 Tournament and the North-Half 5A Regional Championship Tournament;

14 WHEREAS, this remarkable season was truly a team effort, with  
15 equal contributions by 85 uniformed players, 12 coaches, 20  
16 cheerleaders, 2 mascots, 7 trainers and managers, 100 bandmen and

19 endeavors, the Jaguars have brought honor to their school, their  
20 community and to the State of Mississippi:

21 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize

28 5A High School Championship, and extend our heartiest wishes for
