HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 112

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING DR. PATRICK SEWELL AND DR. 2 RALPH VANCE FOR THEIR RESEARCH OF ANOTHER EFFECTIVE TREATMENT FOR LUNG CANCER, OFFICIALLY KNOWN AS THE GUANGZHOU, CHINA, STUDY. 3 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Patrick Sewell and Dr. Ralph Vance traveled to 5 Guangzhou, China, to perform tests and procedures for an effective treatment for lung cancer; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Dr. Sewell, an assistant professor of radiology at the University of Mississippi Medical Center in Jackson, 8 9 Mississippi, developed the interventional radiology procedure called radiofrequency lung tumor ablation and is considered the 10 world's authority on it; and 11 12 WHEREAS, Dr. Sewell performed this procedure for the first 13 time in the world at UMC in 1999, and the Guangzhou, China, Study marked the first time the procedure's effectiveness on primary 14 15 tumors was tested and the first time follow-up PET scans were 16 performed; and WHEREAS, Dr. Vance, an oncologist and UMC professor of 17 medicine, accompanied Dr. Sewell on the first trip to China and 18 designed the protocols for the surgeries for the second trip in 19 20 October 1999; and WHEREAS, the procedure kills cancer cells with a 21 22 radiofrequency probe, which is inserted into the tumors and guided by interventional CAT scan images; and 23 WHEREAS, within a day or two after their surgeries, all of 24 25 the China patients had follow-up PET scans, which detect metabolic activity in live cells, such as cancer cells; and 26

H. C. R. No. 112 00\HR40\R2009.1 PAGE 1 27 WHEREAS, the Guangzhou, China, Study's aim was to prove this 28 procedure kills both metastasized (cancer that has spread) and 29 primary (nonmetastasized) tumors of the lung; and

30 WHEREAS, in Dr. Sewell's procedure, there is less trauma to 31 the body and a much shorter recovery period than for conventional 32 surgery or chemotherapy; and

33 WHEREAS, in 1995, when General Electric invited the Medical 34 Center to be one of the three original test sites in the United 35 States for the MRI, this Legislature quickly responded to the 36 Medical Center's request for funding and committed \$6,000,000.00 37 to be distributed over four years for the project; and

38 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize 39 and commend such outstanding physicians as Dr. Sewell and Dr. 40 Vance, whose research and development will improve the quality of 41 health for the citizens of Mississippi and people all over the 42 world:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Dr. Patrick
Sewell and Dr. Ralph Vance for their outstanding and dedicated
research in developing a new and effective treatment for lung
cancer.
