- 22 serves on the Forum Committee on the Construction Industry, the
- 23 Section of Public Contract Law and the Section of Litigation; and
- 24 WHEREAS, an active member of his community, Mr. Purdy serves
- 25 as the General Counsel for the Associated General Contractors of
- 26 Mississippi, Inc., the Mississippi Associated Builders and

- 27 Contractors, Inc., the Mississippi Road Builders' Association,
- 28 Inc., and as Special Counsel for the Mississippi Asphalt Pavement
- 29 Association, Inc.; and
- 30 WHEREAS, as an Infantry Company Commander of the United
- 31 States Marine Corps, Mr. Purdy received the Bronze Star Medal, the
- 32 Purple Heart Medal and the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry; and
