HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 140
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MRS. ANN WHITE UPON BEING
2 NAMED 1999-2000 YAZOO COUNTY TEACHER OF THE YEAR.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Ann White was recently named 1999-2000 Yazoo
4 County Teacher of the Year and represented her district in a
5 statewide contest; and

6 WHEREAS, Mrs. White, a resident of Flora, Mississippi,
7 furthered her education at institutions of higher learning such as
8 Hinds Community College, University of Mississippi and Holmes
9 Community College; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. White earned a Bachelor's Degree in Education
11 from Belhaven College, a Master's Degree in Education from
12 Mississippi College and completed the World Class Teacher Program
13 at the University of Southern Mississippi; and

14 WHEREAS, in the Fall of 1992, Mrs. White began teaching
15 second grade at Madison Avenue Elementary School, and in 1994, she
16 taught at East Flora Elementary; and

17 WHEREAS, currently, Mrs. White teaches third grade at
18 Bentonia Gibbs Elementary School, where she teaches all subjects
19 including reading, math, language, science and social studies; and

20 WHEREAS, Mrs. White is an active member of many professional
21 organizations including the National Board of Professional
22 Teachers, Mississippi Professional Educators, National Reading
23 Association, Mississippi Reading Association, Phi Delta Kappa
24 International and Phi Theta Kappa; and

25 WHEREAS, Mrs. White has received numerous awards and
26 achievements such as Outstanding Educator in Madison County,

27 Sweetest Teacher at East Flora Elementary School and Teacher of
28 the Year at East Flora Elementary School; and

29 WHEREAS, Mrs. White has been lovingly supported in all her
30 endeavors by her late husband Odie White, Jr., and two children,
31 Jim and Lee Ann; and

32 WHEREAS, this Legislature finds it most appropriate to
33 recognize and commend outstanding educators such as Mrs. Ann
34 White, a teacher dedicated to guiding the young people of this
35 state, who are its future:

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
37 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
38 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Mrs. Ann White
39 upon being named the 1999-2000 Yazoo County Teacher of the Year
40 and express our deepest appreciation for her services as an
41 elementary school teacher in the State of Mississippi.
