- TO ADD A DEFINITION OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES; AND FOR RELATED
- 3 PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-353, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 47-5-353. For the purpose of Sections 47-5-351 through
- 8 47-5-357, the following terms shall have the following meanings
- 9 unless the context shall provide otherwise:
- 10 (a) "Agricultural commodities" means crops, vegetables,
- 11 fruits, livestock, domesticated fish, fowl, seafood, animal
- 12 <u>husbandry</u>, wood, and the various processes that any of these
- 13 commodities may go through subsequent to their removal from the
- 14 <u>soil or water.</u>
- 15 (b) "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of
- 16 Corrections;
- 17 <u>(c)</u> "Department" means the Department of Corrections;
- 18 <u>(d)</u> "Director" means the director of the prison
- 19 agricultural enterprises;
- 20 <u>(e)</u> "Prison agricultural enterprises" means any program
- 21 operated by the Department of Corrections including, but not

- 22 limited to, the growing, harvesting, processing and marketing of
- 23 crops, vegetables, fruits, livestock, domesticated fish, fowl and
- 24 any product of agriculture, animal husbandry or aquaculture that
- 25 may be used for the feeding of prisoners for the general welfare
- of the prisoners or profitably grown on department lands. This
- 27 term includes any proper method of canning, freezing or preserving
- 28 such products;
- 29 <u>(f)</u> "Products" means any item produced by prison
- 30 agricultural enterprises.
- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after its passage.
