SENATE BILL NO. 2055 (As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-353, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO ADD A DEFINITION OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-353, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 47-5-353. For the purpose of Sections 47-5-351 through 8 47-5-357, the following terms shall have the following meanings 9 unless the context shall provide otherwise: 10 (a) <u>"Agricultural commodities" means crops, vegetables</u>, fruits, livestock, domesticated fish, fowl, seafood, animal 11 12 husbandry, wood, and the various processes that any of these 13 commodities may go through subsequent to their removal from the soil or water. 14 "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of 15 (b) Corrections; 16 17 (C) "Department" means the Department of Corrections; (d) "Director" means the director of the prison 18 agricultural enterprises; 19 20 (e) "Prison agricultural enterprises" means any program operated by the Department of Corrections including, but not 21 22 limited to, the growing, harvesting, processing and marketing of crops, vegetables, fruits, livestock, domesticated fish, fowl and 23 any product of agriculture, animal husbandry or aquaculture that 24 25 may be used for the feeding of prisoners for the general welfare 26 of the prisoners or profitably grown on department lands. This

27 term includes any proper method of canning, freezing or preserving 28 such products;

29 (f) "Products" means any item produced by prison
30 agricultural enterprises.

31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after its passage.
