- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-103-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-103-25. The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 10 Higher Learning and the boards of trustees of the junior colleges
- 11 are hereby authorized to prescribe the amount of fees to be paid
- 12 by students attending the several state-supported institutions of
- 13 higher learning and junior colleges of the State of Mississippi.
- 14 In prescribing the rates to be paid by residents of other states,
- 15 the total fees shall not be less than the average cost per student
- 16 from appropriated funds. <u>Provided, however, that the board of</u>
- 17 <u>trustees of any community/junior college district is hereby</u>
- 18 <u>authorized</u>, in its discretion, to waive out-of-state or
- 19 <u>out-of-district tuition for any student living within fifty (50)</u>
- 20 miles of a campus or branch facility of such district.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2000.
