- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> For persons applying for certification to teach
- 8 in Mississippi Kindergarten through Grade 4 after July 1, 2000,
- 9 such certification shall require the completion of a program of
- 10 instruction addressing all reading methods for pupils in
- 11 Kindergarten through Grade 4, in accordance with standards set
- 12 forth by the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
- 13 Learning and the State Board of Education.
- 14 It shall be a requirement for any person to be certified as a
- 15 teacher in Mississippi that the person meet and comply with the
- 16 requirements set forth in the foregoing part of this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2000.
