## SENATE BILL NO. 2135

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROHIBITION OF SMOKING IN THE NEW
- 2 CAPITOL BUILDING; TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSTING OF NONSMOKING SIGNS
- 3 IN THE NEW CAPITOL BUILDING; TO PROVIDE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THIS
- 4 ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) "Smoking" means inhaling, exhaling, burning,
- 7 carrying any lighted cigar or cigarette. Smoking shall be
- 8 prohibited in all enclosed public places within the New Capitol
- 9 Building, including, but not limited to, the following places:
- 10 (a) Elevators.
- 11 (b) Rest rooms, lobbies, reception areas, hallways and
- 12 any other common-use areas.
- 13 (c) All areas available to and customarily used by the
- 14 general public, including every room, chamber, public meeting or
- 15 public assembly area.
- 16 (2) The New Capitol Building shall have posted at every
- 17 entrance a conspicuous sign clearly stating that smoking is
- 18 prohibited.
- 19 (3) All ashtrays and other smoking paraphernalia shall be
- 20 removed from any area where smoking is prohibited by this act by
- 21 the legislative committee or state agency having control of such
- 22 area.

- 23 (4) Enforcement of this act shall be implemented by the
- 24 Capitol Police force with the assistance of the appropriate
- 25 legislative committee or state agency.
- 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2000.
