Section 9-7-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: [WAN1] 6 7 9-7-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, 8 there shall be three (3) judges for the First Circuit Court 9 District. (2) From and after January 1, 2001, there shall be four (4) 10 judges for the First Circuit Court District. The initial term for 11 12 the judgeship created under this subsection shall begin on January 13 1, 2001, and shall end at the same time as the terms of circuit judges generally. The initial holder of the judgeship created by 14 15 this subsection shall be appointed. SECTION 2.
