SENATE BILL NO. 2162

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-2-4, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2001, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF 3 THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY SHALL BE HIRED BY AND 4 SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; 5 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 49-2-4, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 49-2-4. (1) There is *** * *** created the Mississippi 10 Department of Environmental Quality whose offices shall be located 11 in Jackson, Mississippi.

(2) <u>Until December 31, 2000</u>, the department shall be headed 12 by an executive director who shall be appointed by and serve at 13 the pleasure of the Governor. Beginning January 1, 2001, the 14 department shall be headed by an executive director who shall be 15 appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the commission. The 16 appointment of the executive director shall be made with the 17 advice and consent of the Senate. * * * The executive director 18 19 shall have the following minimum qualifications:

(a) A master's degree in a field related to natural
resources, and at least six (6) years' full-time experience in
natural resources, including at least three (3) years of

(b) A bachelor's degree in a field related to natural
resources or administration and at least eight (8) years of
full-time work in the field of natural resources, including four
(4) years of management experience.

28 The executive director <u>is</u> the chief administrative officer of 29 the department.

30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after July 1, 2000.
