- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-7-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 63-7-11. Every vehicle operated upon a highway within this
- 9 state during the period from sunset to sunrise, and at any other
- 10 time when precipitation necessitates the use of windshield wipers
- 11 <u>by vehicle operators or</u> there is not sufficient light to render
- 12 clearly discernible any person on the highway at a distance of
- 13 five hundred (500) feet ahead, shall be equipped with lighted
- 14 front and rear lamps as respectively required in Section 63-7-13
- 15 for different classes of vehicles and subject to exemption with
- 16 reference to lights on parked vehicles as hereinafter stated in
- 17 this chapter.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2000.
