AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-20, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 REQUIRE SUPERVISED HUNT AT THE END OF HUNTER EDUCATION COURSES; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-20, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:[LTR1] 6 7 49-7-20. (1) It is unlawful for any person born on or after 8 January 1, 1972, to procure any hunting license provided by the department unless the person has been issued certification of 9 10 satisfactory completion of a hunter education course approved by the department. After completion of the course work, the 11 department shall require persons under the age of twenty-one (21) 12 to participate in a simulated hunt as a requirement for 13 certification. 14 15 (2) It is unlawful for any person to issue any license 16 provided by the department to any person born on or after January 17 1, 1972, unless the purchaser has provided valid certification of satisfactory completion of a hunter education course approved by 18 the department. 19 20 (3) It is unlawful for any person to fraudulently obtain a hunter education certification. 21
