It shall be unlawful for any person or peace 7 8 officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of 9 10 radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used: 11 12 1. By municipal law enforcement officers of any municipality * * * upon the public streets of the municipality or 13 on any federally designated highway lying within the corporate 14 15 limits; 2. By any college or university campus police force 16 17 within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand (2,000) students are enrolled. 18 * * * 19 20 The Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol will not set up radar 21 on highways within municipalities with a population in excess of
