## SENATE BILL NO. 2304

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO 1 2 3 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) For purposes of this section, the term б "community development corporation" means a nonprofit corporation: 7 (a) That meets the criteria established by the Department of Economic and Community Development; 8 9 That is tax exempt pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of (b) 10 the Internal Revenue Code; (c) Whose primary mission is to develop and improve 11 12 low-income communities and neighborhoods through economic and 13 related development; Whose activities and decisions are initiated, 14 (d) managed and controlled by the constituents of those local 15 communities; and 16 17 (e) Whose primary function is to act as deal-maker and packager of projects and activities that will increase their 18 constituencies' opportunities to become owners, managers and 19 20 producers of small businesses, affordable housing, and jobs designed to produce positive cash flow and curb blight in the 21 22 target community. (2) The Department of Economic and Community Development 23 shall establish a grant program to support community development 24 projects and activities within the state's minority community. 25 26 Any community development corporations may apply for funds under

The Department of Economic and Community 28 Development shall establish and implement performance-based 29 criteria for determining which community development corporations 30 will receive a grant and the amount of the grant. 31 The Department of Economic and Community Development shall 32 allocate Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) each fiscal year to

33 the grant program established in this section.

34 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after July 1, 2000.
