- 2 TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "MUNICIPALITY" IN REGARD TO
- 3 ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPALLY-OWNED RAILROAD TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM;
- 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 21-27-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:[JMR1]
- 8 21-27-11. Whenever used in Sections 21-27-11 through
- 9 21-27-69:
- 10 (a) The term "municipality" includes any incorporated
- 11 city, town or village of the State of Mississippi, whether
- 12 incorporated under a special charter or under the general laws of
- 13 the State of Mississippi governing municipalities, and operating
- 14 under any form of municipal government. However, for the purpose
- 15 of establishing a motor vehicle transportation system for the
- 16 transportation of passengers within the boundaries of the
- 17 governmental unit or units concerned, and within three (3) miles
- 18 thereof, the word "municipality" is defined to include counties
- 19 and groups of municipalities and shall allow those governmental
- 20 units to establish a commission as provided in Section 21-27-13
- 21 and exercise the powers granted in Sections 21-27-11 through
- 22 21-27-69. Each county or municipality joining together shall be

- 23 allowed at least one (1) commissioner representing that governing
- 24 authority. For the purpose of establishing a railroad
- 25 <u>transportation system for passengers and freight, the term</u>
- 26 <u>"municipality" is defined to include any county bordering the</u>
- 27 Mississippi River and in which Highways 49 and 61 intersect, and
- 28 such county may exercise the powers granted in Sections 21-27-11
- 29 <u>through 21-27-69;</u>
- 30 (b) The term "system" includes waterworks system, water
- 31 supply system, sewage system, sewage disposal system, or any
- 32 combination thereof, including any combined waterworks and sewage
- 33 system, consisting of an existing waterworks system or water
- 34 supply system or both, combined with an existing sewage system or
- 35 sewage disposal system or both, or consisting of an existing
- 36 waterworks system or water supply system or both, combined with a
- 37 sewage system or sewage disposal system or both, to be acquired,
- 38 (as defined herein), or consisting of an existing sewage system or
- 39 sewage disposal system or both, combined with a waterworks system
- 40 or water supply system or both, to be acquired, (as defined
- 41 herein), gas producing system, gas generating system, gas
- 42 transmission system or gas distribution system, or any one (1) or
- 43 all thereof, electric generating, transmission, or distribution
- 44 system, garbage disposal system, rubbish disposal system, and
- 45 incinerators, and all parts and appurtenances thereof. The term
- 46 "system" also includes a motor vehicle transportation system for
- 47 the transportation of passengers within the city limits and within
- 48 three (3) miles thereof. The term "system" also includes a
- 49 railroad transportation system of any municipality located within
- 50 a county bordering the Mississippi River and in which Highways 49
- 51 and 61 intersect for the transportation of passengers and freight
- 52 regardless of the amount of area outside the <u>jurisdictional</u> limits
- of such municipality for which the system provides service; the

railroad transportation system may be located partially outside

55 the boundaries of the county. The term "system" also includes a

56 motor vehicle transportation system for the transportation of

57 passengers of any municipality with a population of more than

58 forty-five thousand (45,000) but less than forty-five thousand one

59 hundred (45,100) according to the 1970 federal decennial census

60 regardless of the amount of area outside the city limits of such

61 municipality for which the system provides service. Wherever in

62 Sections 21-27-11 through 21-27-69 any one or more of the systems

authorized under this section are referred to, the same shall

64 include motor vehicle transportation systems. The term "system"

also includes any franchise held by the owner thereof and shall

also include operations within the capabilities of any component

facility within the system which reasonably utilize the public

- 69 (c) The term "improvement" includes repair, betterment,
- 70 enlargement, extension and other improvements to a system;
- 71 (d) The term "acquire" includes construct, purchase,
- 72 gift, exercise of power of eminent domain and other methods by
- 73 which a municipality may acquire a system;
- 74 (e) The term "improve" includes repair, better,
- 75 enlarge, extend and other methods of improving a system;
- 76 (f) The term "ordinance" includes ordinance, resolution
- 77 or other appropriate legislative enactment of the governing
- 78 authorities of any municipality.
- 79 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 80 and after its passage.
