SENATE BILL NO. 2352
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 37-11-54, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP CONFLICT
3 RESOLUTION AND PEER MEDIATION MODELS AND CURRICULA IN THE PUBLIC
4 SCHOOLS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as
7 Section 37-11-54, Mississippi Code of 1972.

8 37-11-54. The State Board of Education shall develop a list
9 of recommended conflict resolution and mediation materials,
10 models, and curricula that address responsible decision making,
11 the causes and effects of school violence and harassment, cultural
12 diversity, and nonviolent methods for resolving conflict,
13 including peer mediation, and shall make the list available to
14 local school administrative units and school buildings by the
15 beginning of the 2001-2002 school year. In developing this list
16 the board shall emphasize materials, models and curricula that
17 currently are being used in Mississippi and that the board
18 determines to be effective. The board shall include at least one
19 (1) model that includes instruction and guidance for the voluntary
20 implementation of peer mediation programs and one (1) model that
21 provides instruction and guidance for teachers concerning the
22 integration of conflict resolution and mediation lessons into the
23 existing classroom curriculum.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
25 and after July 1, 2000.
