- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 43-39-12, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 43-39-12. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this 9
- 10 section, a displaced person shall not be eligible to receive
- relocation payments or any other assistance under this chapter if 11
- the displaced person is an alien not lawfully present in the 12
- 13 United States.
- 14 If a displacing agency determines by clear and
- convincing evidence that a determination of the ineligibility of a 15
- displaced person under subsection (1) of this section would result 16
- in exceptional and extremely unusual hardship to an individual who 17
- is the displaced person's spouse, parent, or child and who is a 18
- citizen of the United States or an alien lawfully admitted for 19
- permanent residence in the United States, the displacing agency 20
- 21 shall provide relocation payments and other assistance to the
- displaced person under this chapter if the displaced person would 22
- be eligible for the assistance but for subsection (1) of this 23

- 25 The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall adopt
- such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the 26
- provisions of this section and in order to comply with federal 27
