SENATE BILL NO. 2363
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE VETERANS'
2 HOME PURCHASE BOARD'S REVOLVING FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING
3 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS' HOME PURCHASE BOARD FOR
4 FISCAL YEAR 2000.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore
7 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9 Treasury to the credit of the Veterans' Home Purchase Board's
10 revolving fund, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
11 Veterans' Home Purchase Board, for the fiscal year ending
12 June 30, 2000.....\$139,000.00.

13 SECTION 2. This additional appropriation is made for the
14 purpose of providing the funds necessary to complete the
15 construction of an office building in Pearl, Mississippi which
16 will house the Mississippi Veterans' Home Purchase Board and the
17 Mississippi Veterans' Affairs Board, and to pay any additional
18 cost and fees associated with this new office building.

19 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
20 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
21 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
22 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
23 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
24 in the manner provided by law.

25 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after its passage and through June 30, 2000.
