- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-3-125, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REVISE THE EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN LAWYERS FROM THE NECESSITY OF
- 3 PAYMENT OF BAR DUES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 73-3-125, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[CSO1]
- 7 73-3-125. All lawyers over the age of seventy-five (75)
- 8 years, and the judges of the Mississippi Supreme Court, Court of
- 9 Appeals of the State of Mississippi, and Mississippi circuit,
- 10 chancery and county judges, United States magistrates, judges of
- 11 the bankruptcy courts, and the judges of the federal courts are
- 12 exempt from the payment of enrollment fees. <u>Lawyers over the age</u>
- 13 of seventy-five (75) years and judges of the classes enumerated in
- 14 this section shall be active members except that no judge shall be
- 15 eligible to membership on the Board of Commissioners. <u>Lawyers who</u>
- 16 have retired from the practice of law because of age, serious
- 17 <u>illness or permanent disability may be placed on inactive status</u>
- 18 and shall be exempt from the payment of enrollment fees.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2000.
