SENATE BILL NO. 2415

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-13-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 AUTHORIZE MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO ENFORCE, UNDER 3 CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, THE PROVISIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI MOTOR 4 VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION LAW THAT REQUIRE THE DISPLAY OF A VALID 5 MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION CERTIFICATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-13-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8

9 63-13-7. (1) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, the Commissioner of Public Safety shall, not more than 10 11 once each year, require that every motor vehicle, trailer, 12 semitrailer and pole trailer registered in this state be inspected and that an official certificate of inspection and approval be 13 obtained for each such vehicle. Each such vehicle must display at 14 all times a certificate of inspection and approval duly issued for 15 16 such vehicle upon the lower left hand corner of the windshield 17 thereof or upon such vehicle in such position as to be visible from the outside. 18

19 (2) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, 20 every motor vehicle registered in any other state and operated 21 over the highways of this state shall be inspected and shall 22 display an inspection certificate which shall be different either

However, the Commissioner of Public Safety may authorize the 25 26 acceptance in this state of a certificate of inspection and approval issued under the authority of a qualified agency or 27 28 department of another state, provided that every municipality, 29 county and state office in such other state accepts under a 30 mutually acceptable reciprocal agreement, Mississippi's 31 certificate of inspection and approval. The commissioner shall except from the provisions of this chapter all passenger buses and 32 other vehicles certified by the United States Department of 33 Transportation and subject to its rules and regulations and its 34 35 periodical inspections.

36 (3) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall require all
37 school buses in the State of Mississippi to be inspected during
38 the months of July or August each year and may provide such
39 special certificate of inspection and approval as he may deem
40 necessary.

41 (4) A motor vehicle manufactured or having a model year 42 earlier than 1961 shall not be required to be inspected or to 43 display a certificate of inspection under the provisions of this 44 chapter.

45 (5) In addition to members of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol, all law enforcement officers of incorporated 46 municipalities of this state, within their respective 47 jurisdiction, may enforce the provisions of this chapter that 48 49 require the display of a valid motor vehicle inspection 50 certificate; provided, however, that a municipal law enforcement 51 officer shall not stop a motor vehicle for a violation of this 52 chapter, or charge an individual with a violation of this chapter,

53 unless the motor vehicle is stopped as a result of some other

55 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 56 and after its passage.
