COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2418

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-7-44, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 CREATE AN ADDITIONAL JUDGESHIP FOR THE SIXTEENTH CIRCUIT COURT
 DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. Section 9-7-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:

9-7-44. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
8 there shall be two (2) judges for the Sixteenth Circuit Court
9 District.

10 (2) From and after July 1, 2000, there shall be three (3) 11 judges for the Sixteenth Circuit Court District. The initial term 12 for the third judgeship created under this section shall begin on 13 July 1, 2000, and shall end at the same time as the terms of

14 circuit judges generally. The initial holder of the third

15 judgeship shall be appointed.

SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

23 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 25 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended, subject to the 26 availability of funds specifically appropriated therefor by the

29 not take effect until the Legislature has funded the

30 implementation thereof by line item appropriation as certified to
