COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2436

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-89-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 EXTEND THE DATE OF THE REPEALER ON THE INFANT MORTALITY TASK 3 FORCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 41-89-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 41-89-1. (1) There is created the Infant Mortality Task
8 Force, the purpose of which is to foster the reduction of infant
9 mortality and morbidity in Mississippi and to improve the health
10 status of mothers and infants.

11 (2) The Infant Mortality Task Force is hereby continued and 12 reconstituted as follows: The task force shall be composed of 13 eleven (11) voting members appointed as follows:

14 (a) The Governor shall appoint seven (7) members, <u>at</u>
15 <u>least</u> one (1) <u>of which shall be appointed</u> from each Mississippi
16 congressional district * * *.

17 (b) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint two (2)18 members from the state at large.

19 (c) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall20 appoint two (2) members from the state at large.

(d) It is the intent of the Legislature that the task
force be comprised of persons with a professional association with
or special interest in maternal and infant health and well-being.
(e) Any member of the Infant Mortality Task Force
appointed and serving prior to July 1, 1995, shall be eligible for
reappointment to the task force.

No. 2436 00\SS01\R726CS PAGE 1 27 (3) The Governor shall appoint two (2) members for initial terms that expire on June 30, 1996, two (2) members for initial 28 29 terms that expire on June 30, 1997, and three (3) members for initial terms that expire on June 30, 1998. The Lieutenant 30 31 Governor and Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one (1) member for an initial term that expires on June 30, 1997, 32 33 and one (1) member for an initial term that expires on June 30, 1998. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for terms of 34 35 three (3) years from the expiration of the previous term. No member shall serve more than two (2) successive full terms. Any 36 vacancy occurring other than by expiration of a term shall be 37 38 filled for the unexpired term by the appropriate appointing 39 authority. An appointment to fill an unexpired term shall not be considered as a full term. 40

(4) The administrative head of the following state agencies 41 42 shall designate one (1) employee to serve in an advisory capacity 43 as an ex officio, nonvoting member of the Infant Mortality Task Force: (a) Mississippi Department of Health; (b) State Department 44 of Education; (c) Department of Human Services; (d) Mississippi 45 Department of Mental Health; (e) Division of Medicaid; and (f) the 46 47 University Medical Center. In addition there shall be one (1) member of the Mississippi Primary Health Care Association who 48 49 shall serve in an advisory capacity as an ex officio nonvoting 50 member.

(5) The Chairman of the Senate Public Health and Welfare Committee and one (1) member of said committee to be designated by the chairman, and the Chairman of the House Public Health and Welfare Committee and one (1) member of said committee to be designated by the chairman shall serve in an advisory capacity as ex officio nonvoting members of the Infant Mortality Task Force.

57 (6) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2003.
58 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
59 and after July 1, 2000.

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
