SENATE BILL NO. 2465

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 INCREASE THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE FULL-TIME DISTRICT ATTORNEYS; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 25-3-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:[JMR1] 6 25-3-35. (1) The annual salaries of the following judges 7 are fixed as follows, to begin at the commencement of the next 8 term of office immediately succeeding the existing term: 9 10 Chief Justice of the Supreme Court..... \$104,900.00 11 Presiding Justice of the Supreme Court..... 102,900.00 Associate Justices of the Supreme Court, each..... 102,300.00 12 However, in addition to their present official duties, there 13 are imposed upon the Supreme Court Justices the extra duties of 14 15 making a special study of existing laws and reporting to each 16 regular session of the Legislature such constructive suggestions 17 as they may deem necessary for the improvement of the administration of justice, and of advising and counseling with the 18 State Librarian in the selection of law books for purchase and use 19 20 in the State Law Library, advising with the librarian thereof upon 21 the removal from the library of any books which may be the least

frequently used, and for the placing of same in a convenient 22 23 location so as to provide additional space for such books and other current publications which may be more frequently used or 24 25 called for. For such extra services each justice, from and after 26 June 17, 1999, shall receive a sum sufficient when added to the 27 present salaries of the justices to aggregate One Hundred Four 28 Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$104,900.00) for the Chief Justice, One Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$102,900.00) for 29 30 the Presiding Justice, and One Hundred Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$102,300.00) for Associate Justices, per annum. As each 31 32 existing term expires and the above-captioned salaries become effective in due course, the extra duties and compensation 33 34 provided for shall cease.

35 (2) The annual salaries of the judges of the Court of36 Appeals of Mississippi are fixed as follows:

37 Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals...... \$ 98,300.00
38 Associate Judges of the Court of Appeals, each.... 95,500.00
39 (3) The annual salaries of the chancery and circuit court
40 judges are fixed as follows:

41 Chancery Judges, each..... \$94,700.00 42 In addition to their present official duties, there are 43 44 imposed upon the chancery and circuit court judges the extra duties of making a special study of existing laws relating to 45 trial courts and reporting to the Supreme Court of the State of 46 47 Mississippi such constructive suggestions as they may deem 48 necessary for the improvement of the administration of justice, 49 which shall be recommended to the Legislature by the Supreme Court 50 in the manner provided by law. The judges shall advise and 51 supervise in the purchase of law books for the libraries of each 52 district, and shall study and evaluate the inventory of books and

No. 2465 00\SS01\R821 PAGE 2 53 facilities now existing in the libraries of each district to 54 effect the removal and relocation of obsolete publications so as to provide additional space for those books and current 55 56 publications more frequently used. The judges shall study the 57 existing rules promulgated by the circuit and chancery court judicial associations governing the operation of chancery and 58 59 circuit courts, and revise the same pursuant to existing laws. For such extra services each judge, from and after June 17, 1999, 60 shall receive a sum sufficient when added to the present salaries 61 62 of the judges to aggregate Ninety-four Thousand Seven Hundred 63 Dollars (\$94,700.00) per annum for each judge. Upon the 64 expiration of the existing term, the above-captioned salaries 65 become effective in due course, and the extra duties and 66 compensation provided for shall cease.

67 (4) The Supreme Court shall prepare a payroll for chancery
68 judges and circuit judges and submit such payroll to the
69 Department of Finance and Administration.

70 (5) The annual salary of the full-time district attorneys
71 shall be <u>Ninety-four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$94,700.00)</u>.
72 (6) The annual salary of the full-time legal assistants

(6) The annual salary of the full-time legal assistants shall be not less than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) nor more than Sixty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$67,500.00), as established by the district attorney.

SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the

83 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 85 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended, or July 1, 2000, 86 whichever occurs later.
