## SENATE BILL NO. 2472 (As Passed the Senate)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-27-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF THE PRACTICE OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 73-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[CRG1]
- 7 73-27-1. (1) The practice of podiatric medicine is that
- 8 profession concerned with the prevention, examination, diagnosis
- 9 and medical, surgical and adjuvant treatment of conditions of the
- 10 human foot. For the purposes of this chapter, "foot" means that
- 11 part of the human anatomy which consists of the tarsal bones,
- 12 metatarsal bones <u>and</u> phalanges. This definition includes all
- 13 supportive and/or connective tissue immediately adjacent to such
- 14 <u>bones</u> not to extend past <u>the synovium attached to</u> the proximal end
- 15 of the talus \* \* \*.
- 16 (2) A podiatrist is a medical care provider who engages in
- 17 the practice of podiatric medicine.
- 18 (3) A podiatrist may prescribe and administer drugs and
- 19 tests, excluding general and spinal anesthesia, that are essential
- 20 to the practice of podiatric medicine when used for or in
- 21 connection with treatment of disorders of the human foot.
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after its passage.
