SENATE BILL NO. 2484
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-21-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO REVISE THE RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER PROCEDURE; AND FOR
3 RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. Section 59-21-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:[LTR1]

7 59-21-13. An application for renewal of a certificate of
8 number shall be made by the owner on an application * * * which
9 must be received by the commission within * * * the last ninety
10 (90) days before the expiration date on the certificate of number.

11 The same number will be issued upon renewal. * * * If a
12 certificate of number is lost or destroyed, the owner shall,
13 within fifteen (15) days, notify the commission's office. The
14 notification shall be in writing, shall describe the circumstances
15 of the loss or destruction and shall be accompanied by the fee
16 prescribed in this chapter. The certificate of number issued as a
17 result of such report will replace the certificate so lost or
18 destroyed.

19 The commission shall mail notice of expiration of numbers,
20 together with an application for renewal of number, to each
21 registered boat owner not less than sixty (60) days prior to the
22 expiration date. The commission shall verify annually an
23 up-to-date list of all numbers in effect and those numbers not
24 renewed.

25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after July 1, 2000.
