## SENATE BILL NO. 2499

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-519, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1	1972,

- TO PERMIT THE USE OF RADAR SPEED DETECTION EQUIPMENT BY ROSS
- BARNETT RESERVOIR PATROL OFFICERS DULY APPOINTED AND COMMISSIONED
- 4 BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PEARL RIVER VALLEY WATER SUPPLY
- 5 DISTRICT WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED
- 6 PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:[CSQ1]
- 10 63-3-519. It shall be unlawful for any person or peace
- 11 officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway
- 12 Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of
- 13 radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or
- 14 highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used:
- 1. By municipal law enforcement officers within a
- 16 municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more
- 17 upon the public streets of the municipality;
- 18 2. By any college or university campus police force
- 19 within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand
- 20 (2,000) students are enrolled;
- 3. By municipal law enforcement officers in any
- 22 municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand
- 23 (15,000) according to the latest federal census on federally

- 24 designated highways lying within the corporate limits;
- 25 <u>4. By any qualified person appointed by the Board of</u>
- 26 <u>Directors of the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District pursuant</u>
- 27 to Sections 51-9-171 through 51-9-185 upon the property which is
- 28 <u>owned by the district to include property which is owned by the</u>
- 29 <u>district but has been leased or rented to other parties and all</u>
- 30 roads and highways located within the district.
- The Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol will not set up radar
- 32 on highways within municipalities with a population in excess of
- 33 fifteen thousand (15,000) according to the latest federal census.
- 34 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after July 1, 2000.
