SENATE BILL NO. 2508 (As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 CREATE WITHIN THE HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL THE POSITION OF STATEWIDE 3 SAFETY TRAINING OFFICER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 45-1-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:[CSQ1] 7 45-1-2. (1) The Executive Director of the Department of Public Safety shall be the Commissioner of Public Safety. 8 9 (2) The Mississippi Department of Public Safety shall be organized into the following offices: 10 (a) Office of Public Safety Planning; 11 Office of Medical Examiner; 12 (b) 13 Office of Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol; Office of Crime Laboratories; 14 (d) Office of Law Enforcement Officers' Training 15 (e) 16 Academy; (f) Office of Support Services. 17 The department shall be headed by a commissioner who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

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- 20 The appointment of the commissioner shall be made with the advice
- 21 and consent of the Senate. The commissioner may assign to the
- appropriate offices such powers and duties as deemed appropriate 22
- to carry out the department's lawful functions. 23
- (4) The commissioner of the department shall appoint heads 24
- 25 of offices, who shall serve at the pleasure of the commissioner.
- The commissioner shall have the authority to organize the offices 2.6

- 27 established by subsection (2) of this section as deemed
- 28 appropriate to carry out the responsibilities of the department.
- 29 The organization charts of the department shall be presented
- 30 annually with the budget request of the Governor for review by the
- 31 Legislature.
- 32 (5) The commissioner of the department shall appoint a
- 33 statewide safety training officer who shall serve at the pleasure
- 34 of the commissioner and whose duty it shall be to perform public
- 35 <u>training for both law enforcement and private persons throughout</u>
- 36 the state concerning proper emergency response to the mentally
- 37 <u>ill, terroristic threats or acts, domestic conflict, other</u>
- 38 <u>conflict resolution</u>, and such other matters as the commissioner
- 39 <u>may direct</u>.
- 40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 41 and after July 1, 2000.
