- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) That portion of Mississippi Highway 8,
- beginning at the intersection of Mississippi Highway 8 and U.S.
- Highway 45 and extending the intersection of Mississippi Highway 8 9
- 10 and Oakland Drive, shall be known as "Jo Doss Miller Memorial
- 11 Drive."
- The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 12
- 13 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- 14 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 65-3-71.49, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 15
