## SENATE BILL NO. 2556

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 69-7-253, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MISSISSIPPI EGG MARKETING BOARD;
AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 69-7-253, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

6 amended as follows:[HS1]

7 69-7-253. There is hereby continued the Mississippi Egg Marketing Board with domicile at the capital city of the state. 8 The board shall be composed of five (5) members: one (1) member 9 shall be the Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce as ex 10 officio member. One (1) member shall be an egg producer as 11 defined in this article. Three (3) members shall be employed by 12 or associated with egg industry related businesses, or disciplines 13 which include poultry support, marketing, promotion, home 14 15 economist, extension poultry science agencies and the Mississippi 16 Department of Agriculture and Commerce. No more than one (1) industry-related business or discipline member shall be employed 17 by, associated with or have a financial interest in the same 18 19 company or subsidiary.

20 The <u>Governor shall appoint the members</u>, with the advice and 21 consent of the Senate. <u>The Governor shall appoint a member</u> from a

No. 2556 00\SS26\R687 PAGE 1 list of not <u>more</u> than three (3) producers <u>and not less than</u> three (3) individuals representing egg industry related businesses or disciplines, provided by the board based upon a poll of its members. <u>The terms shall be for six (6) years.</u> Each member shall serve, after the completion of his term, until his successor is appointed and duly qualified. Each vacancy shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term.

The terms of office of persons appointed under the original act shall continue until the expiration of the terms to which they were appointed, the intent of this article being to continue the Mississippi Egg Marketing Board.

33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2000.
