SENATE BILL NO. 2564 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-3-121, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO ALLOW INSURANCE AGENTS TO FINANCE CERTAIN INSURANCE PREMIUMS; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 83-3-121, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended follows:

7 83-3-121. No insurance company, or employee thereof, and no 8 broker or agent shall knowingly charge, demand, or receive a 9 premium for any policy of insurance except in accordance with the applicable filing approved in the manner herein provided. No such 10 insurer or employee or agent thereof shall pay, allow, or give, or 11 12 offer to pay, allow, or give, directly or indirectly, as an 13 inducement to insurance or after insurance has been affected, any rebate, discount, abatement, credit, or reduction of the premium 14 named in a policy of insurance, or any special favor or advantage 15 in the dividends or other benefits to accrue thereon, or any 16 valuable consideration or inducement whatever, not specified in 17 the policy of insurance. No insured named in a policy of 18 insurance nor any employee of such insured shall knowingly receive 19 20 or accept, directly or indirectly, any such rebate, discount, abatement, or reduction of premium, or any special favor or 21 advantage or valuable consideration or inducement. Nothing herein 22 contained shall be construed as prohibiting the payment of 23 commissions or other compensation to duly licensed agents, nor as 24 prohibiting any participating insurer from distributing to its 25 policyholders dividends, savings, or the unused or unabsorbed 26

28 <u>duly licensed agent from advancing an insurance premium for the</u>

29 insured with or without interest thereon subject to the rules and

30 regulations of the Mississippi Department of Insurance.

31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after July 1, 2000.
