SENATE BILL NO. 2571
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL
2 FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE THROUGH
3 THE STATE AND SCHOOL EMPLOYEES' LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN FOR
4 ALL QUALIFIED COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGE EMPLOYEES, AND TO
5 PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SPECIAL FUND SPENDING AUTHORITY FROM THE WORK
6 FORCE CARRYOVER FUND FOR THE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING PROGRAM, FOR
7 FISCAL YEAR 2000.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore
10 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
12 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
13 funding life and health insurance through the State and School
14 Employees' Life and Health Insurance Plan for all qualified
15 community and junior college employees, for the fiscal year ending
16 June 30, 2000.....\$ 389,114.00.

17 SECTION 2. In addition to all other sums heretofore
18 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
19 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Work
20 Force Carryover Fund No. 3292, to the State Board for Community
21 and Junior Colleges for the for the fiscal year ending
22 June 30, 2000.....\$ 1,300,000.00.

23 The money appropriated in this Section is to provide the
24 additional special fund spending authority needed to cover the
25 additional industrial training funds transferred from the State
26 Department of Education to the State Board for Community and
27 Junior Colleges for the Industrial Training Program as authorized
28 by Senate Bill No. 2796, 1999 Regular Session.

29 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
31 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
32 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
33 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
34 in the manner provided by law.

35 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
36 and after its passage.
