SENATE BILL NO. 2607

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
2 TO CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, STRAIGHTEN AND REALIGN A CERTAIN
3 SEGMENT OF HIGHWAY IN PANOLA COUNTY, TO DESIGNATE SUCH HIGHWAY
4 SEGMENT AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO PLACE SUCH
5 HIGHWAY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION;
6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
9 shall construct, reconstruct, straighten and realign the following
10 highway, which highway is designated as a state highway and is
11 placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi Transportation
12 Commission for construction and maintenance; and such highway,
13 together with the highways designated in Sections 65-3-3 and
14 65-3-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, and all other laws adding links
15 to the designated state highway system, are declared to be the
16 state highway system of Mississippi:

17 Northern District - Panola County:

18 Beginning at presently designated MS 315 in Section 30,
19 Township 8 South, Range 5 West, thence southeasterly to intersect
20 MS 6 in Section 32, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, being
21 approximately 2.2 miles in length.

22 (2) The mileage of highway specifically designated in
23 subsection (1) of this section is in addition to the total mileage

24 limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600) miles that is set
25 out in Section 65-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972.

26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
27 and after July 1, 2000.
