## SENATE BILL NO. 2664

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE \$1.50 WITNESS APPEARANCE FEE IN STATE COURT; TO REVISE 3 MILEAGE PAID TO WITNESSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 25-7-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 25-7-47. Witnesses in the county, circuit, and chancery courts shall receive a witness fee in the amount allowable to 8 witnesses in the federal courts and the mileage reimbursement rate 9 10 allowable to federal employees for the use of a privately owned 11 vehicle while on official travel for each mile going to and returning from the courthouse to their homes by the nearest route, 12 and such tolls and ferriages as they may actually be obliged to 13 pay; but mileage, toll, and ferriage shall be charged but once at 14 15 each term of court, and a charge shall not be made for mileage except that traveled in this state. Witnesses before a justice 16 court judge shall be allowed the federal witness appearance fee 17 per day and no more. Witnesses in all other cases shall receive 18 the same compensation as they receive before the circuit court. 19 20 It shall not be necessary to issue subpoenas for police officers 21 as witnesses in city cases of cities having a population of more

S. B. No. 2664 00\SS03\R250 PAGE 1 than ten thousand (10,000) according to the Federal Census of 1930; and such officers, when used as witnesses in such cases, are not to be allowed witness fees.

25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after July 1, 2000.
